CORE CONSIDERATIONS

Supports **designed by person** & their family

A '**normalising**' approach

Focus on **roles, strengths** & life history - moving away from deficits.

Naturally occurring family & community supports, mainstream services and formal health & social care supports – **care and support ecosystem.**

IMPACT

3,299 people provided with personalised supports in the community

- **1,476** people with dementia
- **1,823** family carers

Training & support hours

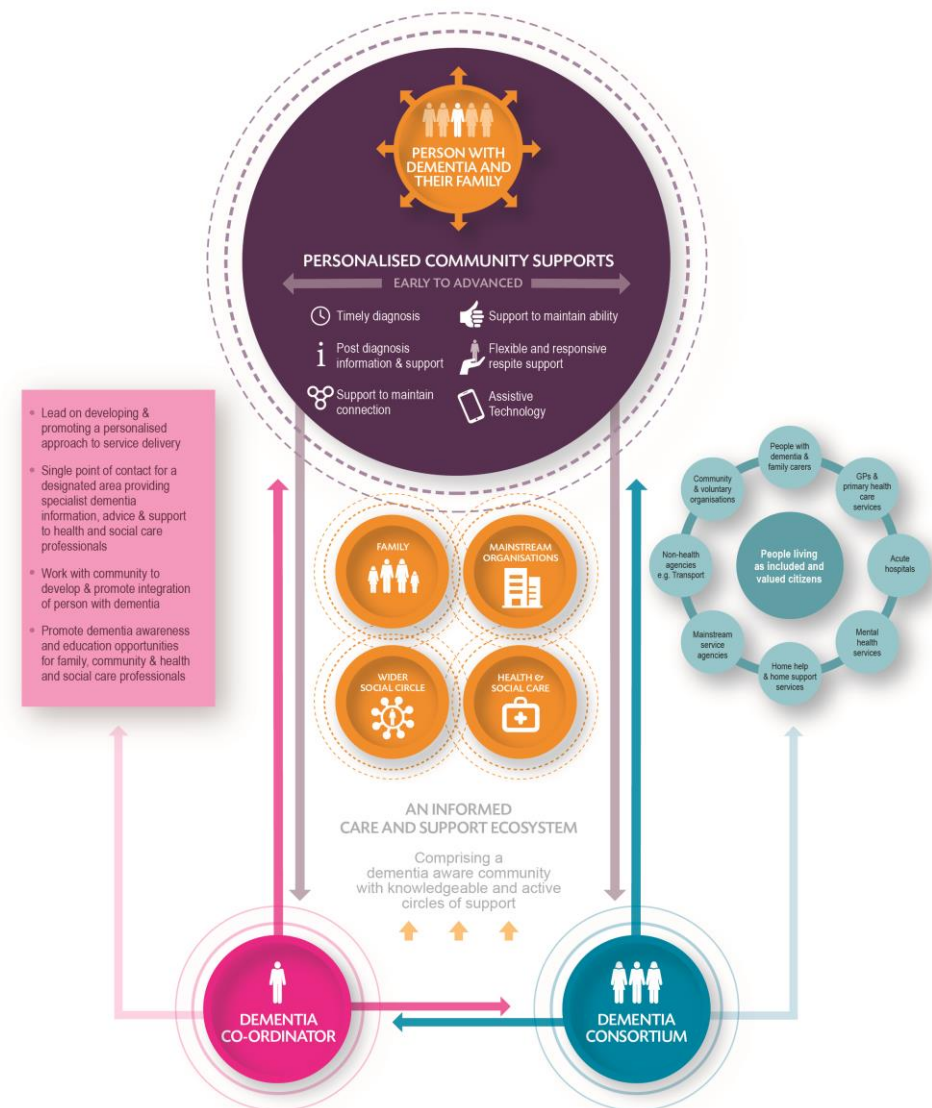
- **67,473** personalised support hours provided
